

## Fireworks Ordinance

Ordinance No. 1429 (#17-2011) stated permits could be obtained for private use of firework displays, but that has changed. Ordinance 1614 (#21-2019) states, "Jacksonville Municipal Code Section 8.16.030 (Display of Fireworks – Private Property) is hereby repealed in its entirety."

Remember, the Sale or Discharge of Fireworks is PROHIBITED. Any person(s) guilty of violation shall be fined a minimum of \$250, no more than \$750 per offence, together with applicable court costs. This means no fireworks are authorized inside city limits for any reason. You may not possess them, nor use them.

However, a public fireworks display is authorized on public property with prior approval from the Fire Marshal. The city provides this during the 4th of July Fireworks show at the Jacksonville Shooting Range each year.
